

## Are you from Iraq? Have you been refused refugee status?

If so, because of a recent court case, you may be able to ask the **Home Office\*** to reconsider your claim. This may be possible if:

- You are a national of Iraq
- Your asylum claim was first refused by the **Home Office\*** between 1<sup>st</sup> October 2000 and 20<sup>th</sup> March 2003
- At the time your asylum claim was refused, the Saddam regime controlled the area you lived in, in Iraq
- Your refusal letter stated that you could have relocated to the Kurdish Autonomous Zone
- You have not been granted **Indefinite Leave to Remain\***

It is important that you contact a solicitor as soon as possible. Please ask a caseworker if you have any questions.
